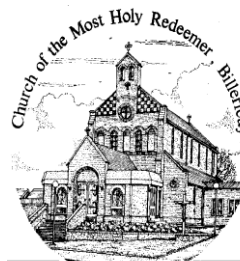

On January, 25<sup>th</sup> a group of parishioners met with me to pray and to reflect on the book, "Forming Intentional Disciples" written by the American author Sherry Weddell.

The central premise of the book is that a living, personal relationship with Christ is fundamental to our Catholic faith and that our parishes should be places where that relationship is nurtured, developed and also made available to those who don't currently know God's love in their lives.

Over the last six months we have taken two chapters of the book at a time and have discussed how the chapters apply to our own lives as Catholic Christians. This week we came to the end of the book and have made a commitment to continue to meet together as a Parish Evangelisation Group so that we can, through the guidance of the Holy Spirit, explore new ways for us as a parish to go deeper in our faith.

If you are interested in being part of this process then you would be very welcome to come along to our next meeting which will take place on Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> July at 7.30pm in the Parish Centre. At this meeting we will be looking at the possibility of running an Alpha Course in the parish later in the year.

Even if you decide not to join this group, I would ask all of you to keep the work of the group in your prayers to enable many more people to hear and to believe the Good News that Jesus offers us through His Church. *Fr Dan*

## Church Opening Hours:

**Emmanuel Church Car Park:** A gentle reminder to parishioners to avoid parking in the Emmanuel Church car park when you come to Mass at the weekend.

**Sick and Housebound Parishioners:** If you know any parishioners who are now unable to come to Mass and who would like a visit from the Parish Visiting Group or from Father Dan please could you contact the Parish Office on 01277 624891 with their contact details.

If you have a relative who is going into hospital and you would like them to be visited please make sure that you contact the Parish Office with their name and the hospital ward that they are in.

**Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer:** If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.

**Children's Liturgy:** Parents are respectfully asked not to go out with their children for the Children's Liturgy at the 9am & 11am Masses unless their children are below school age and in the Toddlers' Liturgy.
