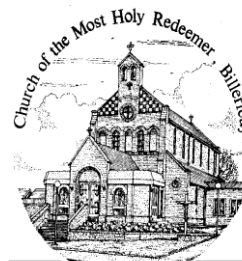

In the heart of the Old City of Jerusalem lies the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the most important place of worship in the whole of Christendom. Within the Church lies the site of Jesus' crucifixion at Calvary and the place where his body was laid to be buried and every year thousands of pilgrims from across the world come to worship.

Because the church is so important within Christianity it may not be surprising that ownership of the church remains a matter of controversy. In a complicated arrangement that was drawn up 160 years ago, control of the church is shared out between the Greek Orthodox, the Armenian Orthodox and the Roman Catholic Churches. Over the years there have been disputes over which church is responsible for repairs to the building and there have even been fights between members of the different churches when one faction has felt that another is intruding into their territory.

In some ways you could say that the Church of the Holy Sepulchre is a microcosm of the divisions that have scarred Christianity for hundreds of years. As we mark the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity we should re-commit ourselves through our prayers and actions to making Jesus' prayer to His Father a reality: "Just as you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be one in us" *Fr Dan*
