“To turn the other cheek” is a phrase that has entered into common usage but the phrase actually originates from the words of Jesus in today's gospel. Sadly, this phrase is often misunderstood by people who think that it's saying that when you are confronted by violence all you can do is to allow the person who has committed the violent act to carry on.

In fact, “turn the other cheek” has a much deeper meaning, one which is exemplified by the story of Barry and Margaret Mizen, the parents of Jimmy Mizen. In 2008, Jimmy, who was then 16 years old, had gone to buy his first lottery ticket. While he was in a bakery with his brother he came across a young man who he knew. This man challenged Jimmy to a fight but when Jimmy refused to leave the shop the man took a glass dish from the counter and threw it at Jimmy. The glass shattered and a shard severed vital blood vessels. Jimmy managed to make his way to the back of the shop where he died.

The man who killed Jimmy was arrested and Jimmy's parents were asked by the reporters who were covering the case whether they hated him for what he had done. Jimmy's mother replied: “How can I hate him? It's hate that killed my Jimmy. Anger breeds anger and that is what killed my son.”

Barry and Margaret Mizen established the Jimmy Mizen Foundation and continue to visit schools and prisons to talk to young people about the effects of violence and to promote peace. *Fr Dan*
