There is an old story told about the Battle of Waterloo which was fought in 1815 between the French navy, led by Napoleon Bonaporte, and the British fleet commanded by the Duke of Wellington.

The battle was fought at a time before modern communications and so the only way that the people of England knew how the battle was progressing was through a system of semaphore signals. One of these signals was stationed on the tower of Winchester Cathedral. Late in the day it flashed the signal: "Wellington defeated". Just at that moment the signal was obscured by cloud and the whole countryside was plunged into deep despair. Then suddenly the fog lifted and the rest of the message became clearly visible: "Wellington defeated...the enemy!" Within the space of a moment, sorrow was turned into joy and defeat was replaced by victory.

We hear about a similar sense of exaltation when Jesus appears to the disciples on Easter Sunday. Having experienced the horror of witnessing his death on the cross, they are overwhelmed when he appears before them after the resurrection in a glorified body. As St Clement of Alexandria, one of the early Church Fathers, put it: "Christ has turned all our sunsets into dawns."

During the season of Eastertide we rejoice that Jesus, through his own death and resurrection, offers all of those who believe in Him the opportunity of new life. We pray that we may be able to join with the disciples in saying: "Alleluia! He is Risen!" *Fr Dan*
