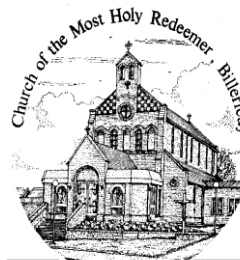

I came across an article during the week which used a phrase which has stayed with me all week. Describing the state of faith in the Western World the writer of the article said that what we are currently undergoing is a "spiritual climate change."

What he meant by this is that whereas in the past, the culture in most Western countries was broadly sympathetic to religious belief, and to Christianity in particular, now we can no longer assume that this is the case. Just as climate change has caused the weather patterns to become more volatile, more unpredictable and in some cases more hostile to human beings, so spiritual climate change has created a more challenging environment for those who want to practise their faith.

Changes in legislation and social attitudes, and in particular changes to family life have all meant that people's understanding of the Christian faith and their lived experience of that faith have declined. We only need to track the increase in the number of people in this country identifying themselves as atheists to see this being born out.

In the face of such profound changes, just as with climate change, we have a choice: we can either deny that the changes are taking place or we can try to face the challenge head on and continue to proclaim the truth of the message given to us by Jesus Christ. *Fr Dan*
