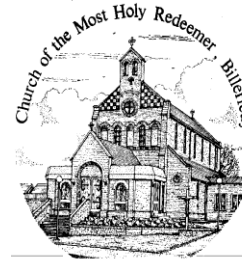

How many times have we heard Jesus say in the gospels that in order to be His disciples we must bear fruit? The question this raises of course is: what does Jesus mean by "bearing fruit"? How do we know that we are bearing fruit both as individual Catholics and as a parish community.

This week I attended a Conference entitled "Maintenance to Mission" which addressed this very question head on. Traditionally we have understand Jesus to mean that "bearing fruit" means living a good Catholic life but one of the speakers at the Conference, a Canadian priest called Father James Mallon, put it another way.

Father James said that to bear fruit within a parish context means "to invite other people to come to know Jesus Christ." All of the events, all of the programmes that a parish puts on should be judged by how successful they are in inviting people to come to know Jesus Christ.

Just imagine if everyone at Most Holy Redeemer managed to persuade one person they know to come to Mass with them next week. We would double our Church and more importantly we would give that person the greatest gift we can: the gift of our faith.

You will be hearing a lot more over the coming months about becoming an invitational church but I would begin by asking all of you to pray: to pray for our parish but also to pray for all of the people we know who don't have a knowledge of Jesus but who are just waiting to be asked. *Fr Dan*
