I would like to thank all of you who have taken the time to comment on the proposed changes to the interior of our church.

One comment that was expressed is that while we have a display at the back of the church outlining the proposed works, I haven't explained why I believe these changes to be necessary. I think this is a fair point and I would like to briefly outline why I am proposing moving the Blessed Sacrament to the sanctuary of the church and creating a Sacred Heart chapel.

Our parish rejoices in the title of "The Most Holy Redeemer" and yet currently we have no statue of Our Lord visible in the church apart from the statue of the Virgin with child. Creating a chapel dedicated to the Sacred Heart will, I believe, strengthen our devotion to and our connection with Jesus Christ.

In the same way, I strongly favour having the Blessed Sacrament placed in a prominent position behind the altar in the sanctuary area not only because it makes the Blessed Sacrament more visible but because it also sends out a clear statement that Jesus is at the centre of our worship and at the centre of our lives as Catholic Christians. I am also of the mind that relocating the Blessed Sacrament will increase reverence for the Eucharist by reminding people of the importance of genuflecting before they take their seats.

For those of you who are unsure about these proposals, I hope that this explanation goes some way towards helping you understand why I think they are needed. I have been praying about these changes for several months and sincerely believe that they will enhance both the spiritual and the liturgical life of our parish community. *Fr Dan*
