Last Thursday, priests from all over the diocese gathered together at St Edmund's College in Hertfordshire for a special Mass to mark the end of our year long celebrations to commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of our diocese.

The occasion was particularly poignant for those men who had trained for the priesthood at St Edmund's. Until 1975, when the seminary was relocated to Chelsea in Central London on the site of St Thomas More's old house, St Edmund's had been the Westminster diocesan seminary. It also has a particular connection with our own diocese because the first Bishop of Brentwood, Bishop Ward, had been a student and then the Rector of St Edmund's before being appointed as Bishop.

During the year long celebrations marking the centenary of the founding of our diocese we have had an opportunity to look back and to give thanks for the way that the Lord has blessed the Catholic community in Essex and East London. If Bishop Ward was alive today I'm sure he would be amazed at the number of thriving parishes and successful Catholic schools we have. But as well as looking back, it is also important to plan for the future. In the coming weeks the diocese will be issuing a document outlining the challenges that lie ahead for us in the coming years. I would urge you to read this document when it is available and to continue to pray for, and to encourage, vocations to the priesthood and the religious life so that we can ensure that the next hundred years are as fruitful as the last century has been. *Fr Dan*

**Re-ordering of the Sanctuary and Blessed Sacrament Chapel:** Thank you to all of you who have commented on the proposals for the re-ordering of the church which have been displayed in the church porch. The overall consensus has been in favour of the plans. The builders will now begin working this Wednesday (22nd). This means that the church will be closed from Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> until Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> November. **While the church is closed the 9.15am Parish Masses on Wednesday and Thursday will take place in Rooms 2 and 3 of the Pastoral Centre.
