A heresy is a false or erroneous belief and when it comes to preaching about the Holy Trinity, this is something that is particularly easy to do if you are not careful. So rather than writing about what our belief in the Trinity is, I thought I would highlight what the Trinity isn't by looking at 4 common heresies preached about the Trinity.

1. Denying the personhood of the Holy Spirit: the Holy Spirit is a person just as much as the Father and Son. He is not a “force,” and he is not simply “God’s actions in the world.” He is a full and distinct person. This is easy to forget since his name isn’t as personal as “Father” and “Son,” and he is often represented with non-personal things, such as the dove.
2. Modalism: This is an ancient heresy which said that the three persons of the Trinity are just 3 modes or masks that God switches between. This is usually preached when the Trinity is compared to a person having multiple roles (eg mother, daughter, wife). While this simplifies things, it’s also wrong: all 3 persons of the Trinity exist eternally and concurrently. The persons are not just different jobs or forms that God has.
3. Claiming that the God of the Old Testament is just the Father: The 3 persons of the Trinity, including the Son and the Holy Spirit, exist eternally and act together in perfect harmony. This means that the God revealed in the Old Testament is the same God who was Incarnated in the person of Jesus.
4. Tritheism: While there are 3 persons in the Trinity it’s also important to make it clear that we believe there is only one God. While the 3 persons of the Trinity are all divine, they are not 3 Gods. Instead, they all share the same divine substance (or, as the Nicene Creed puts it “are consubstantial with the Father”). **Fr Dan**

**Novena to the Sacred Heart:** Starting this Wednesday (30th May) we will be having nine days of prayer leading up to the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, 8th June. Please take a copy of the Novena Booklet which is available at the back of the church.

**Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer:** If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.

**Parish Centre Alarm:** All parish groups should be aware that the Parish Centre is frequently alarmed. If any groups do not know the code for the alarm then they should contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**Emmanuel Church Car Park:** A gentle reminder to parishioners to avoid parking in the Emmanuel Church car park when you come to Mass at the weekend. They have no spaces available for Funeral parking this week.
