Our Parish is twinned with Sacred Heart Parish, Dundee Diocese, South Africa

The historic town of Orvieto is situated on a rock cliff in the Italian region of Umbria. Inside the medieval cathedral there is a relic which recalls a eucharistic miracle which took place over 700 years ago.

In 1263 a German priest, Peter of Prague, stayed in the nearby village of Bolsena while on a pilgrimage to Rome. Peter was a good priest but one who struggled to believe that Christ was actually present in the consecrated Host. While celebrating Mass above the tomb of St. Christina he had barely spoken the words of Consecration when blood started to seep from the consecrated Host and trickle over his hands onto the altar and the linen corporal.

The priest was confused. At first he attempted to hide the blood, but then he interrupted the Mass and asked to be taken to Orvieto, the city where Pope Urban IV was staying. The Pope listened to the priest's account and absolved him. He then began an investigation. When all the facts were established, he ordered the Communion Host and the corporal bearing the stains of blood to be brought to Orvieto to be placed in the cathedral.

Pope Urban IV was prompted by this miracle to issue a papal bull in 1264 instituting the feast we celebrate today, the feast of Corpus Christi.

In August 1964, on the 700th anniversary of the institution of the feast of Corpus Christi, Pope Paul VI celebrated Mass at the altar where the linen corporal is kept in the Cathedral of Orvieto. 12 years later, the same pontiff visited Bolsena and described the Eucharist as being "... a mystery great and inexhaustible." *Fr Dan*

Church Opening Hours: We are fortunate to be able to keep our church open most days during the week but sometimes the church has to be closed early if Father Dan is away or there is nobody available to lock up. As a rough guide these are the hours that the church is normally open during the weekdays:

Thursday: 8am-9pm

Novena to the Sacred Heart: The nine days of prayer continues, leading up to the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, 8th June.

Confessions and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Please note that there will **not be** Confessions and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from **11am to 12pm on Saturday, 16th June** because Father Dan will be attending a diaconate ordination at Brentwood Cathedral on that day.

Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer: If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.

Parish Centre Alarm: All parish groups should be aware that the Parish Centre is frequently alarmed. If any groups do not know the code for the alarm then they should contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.
