It was a great delight for me personally and for our parish community to be able to invite Father Bill Nix back to Billericay this week to celebrate his Golden Anniversary of ordination to the priesthood.

Not only was Father Bill the Assistant Priest here at the Most Holy Redeemer with Father Geoffrey Pye before returning as Parish Priest from 1978 to 1990, he was also my first Parish Priest after I was ordained and was asked by the Bishop to go to the Cathedral in Brentwood.

During the four years I spent with Father Bill as his curate, he taught me a number of important things but the one that remains with me most clearly is his advice about hearing confessions. He told me a story about a newly ordained priest who asked his Parish Priest for advice about hearing confessions. The Parish Priest said to him: “I have three tips: Be kind, be kind and be kind.”

That story has always stayed with me and I know that this is a maxim that Father Bill has always followed in all of the parishes that he has worked in.

The fact that so many of you wanted to be part of his anniversary celebrations on Friday evening is a testament to the difference that a good priest can make. My prayer is that Father Bill's witness may encourage others to follow his example so that one day in the not too distant future we may be able to celebrate an ordination to the priesthood here at the Most Holy Redeemer. *Fr Dan*

**Novena to the Sacred Heart:** The nine days of prayer continues, leading up to the celebration of the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, 8th June.

**Confessions and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament:** Please note that there will **not be** Confessions and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from **11am to 12pm on Saturday, 16<sup>th</sup> June** because Father Dan will be attending a diaconate ordination at Brentwood Cathedral on that day.

**Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer:** If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.

**Parish Centre Alarm:** All parish groups should be aware that the Parish Centre is frequently alarmed. If any groups do not know the code for the alarm then they should contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.
