This Sunday is not only Remembrance Sunday but it also marks the centenary of the signing of the Armistice Treaty which ended the First World War. After four years of conflict, it is estimated that by 1918 over 16 million people, both civilians and military personnel, had died. Many others sustained injuries which were life changing. The First World War proved to be one of the deadliest conflicts ever fought.

The author L.P. Hartley once wrote: “The past is a foreign country, they do things differently there” and as we commemorate the ending of the First World War it can be difficult to get a sense of what it must have been like to have been a young man fighting in the trenches of the Western Front.

Fortunately we have two things which can help us. Firstly, technology has enabled us to view photographs and cine film that were taken at the time, not only in black and white as they were originally shot but also now in colour. Seeing these images in colour makes them seem more real and more immediate.

We also have the poetry that was written by men who had experienced the horrors of the war first hand. Even though they were written a century ago, the poetry of Siegfried Sassoon, Wilfred Owen, Rupert Brooke and many others vividly capture what it was like to fight on the Front.

As we commemorate their sacrifice and pray that our generation and future generations will never have to endure what they did, a fitting tribute would be to read one of the poems written by these poets and to pray for God’s peace upon them and on all those who died. *Fr Dan*

**Church Opening Hours:** We are fortunate to be able to keep our church open most days during the week but sometimes the church has to be closed early if Father Dan is away or there is nobody available to lock up. **Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer:** If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.

**New Parishioners:** If you are new to our parish, do please introduce yourself to Father Dan at the end of Mass. New parishioners are encouraged to fill in a registration form which can be found in the church porch. We are also able to arrange a visit from some existing parishioners if you would like more information about what is available in our parish.

**Parish Centre Alarm:** All parish groups should be aware that the Parish Centre is frequently alarmed. If any groups do not know the code for the alarm then they should contact the Parish Office as soon as possible.

**Confirmation 2019 Registration Evening** On Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> December at 7.30pm in the Church we will hold a Registration Evening for all of those young people in Year 10 and above who would like to be confirmed in our parish next year on Pentecost Sunday. In order to join the Confirmation programme it is essential that you attend this meeting. If you are not able to come to the meeting you will need to contact the Parish Office in advance of the date. After the 11<sup>th</sup> December it will no longer be possible to join the programme. Please note that Confirmation sessions require attendance at the Sunday 5pm Mass and on Sunday evenings.

It will not be possible for Father Dan to issue the Certificate of Catholic Practice if parents do not have a copy of their child's baptism certificate with them.
