

Our Parish is twinned with Sacred Heart Parish, Dundee Diocese, South Africa

In order to help prepare them to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, the sixteen young people who are part of our parish Confirmation programme have been following the "Youth Alpha" course.

"Youth Alpha" is an off shoot of the "Alpha Course" which originated at Holy Trinity Brompton and has gone on to be used in different churches and denominations across the world. Every week each session begins with a simple shared meal and a video presentation on a different theme and an opportunity to participate in discussions about the questions that are linked to that theme.

The course is designed in such a way that the sessions naturally lead to what is the most important part of the course which is the "Holy Spirit Day". During the day, which is designed to be like a mini retreat, time is given for those participating to reflect on the role of the Holy Spirit in their lives. At the end of the day there is also an opportunity for those who wish to take part in prayer ministry.

The experience of those who have participated both in Alpha and Youth Alpha is that the Holy Spirit day is often the most impactful and meaningful part of the course because it enables the Holy Spirit to work more fully in the lives of those who are attending.

You could say that Pentecost is our "Holy Spirit Day" a time for us to celebrate the many ways in which the Holy Spirit is working in our lives. At Pentecost, the lives of the Apostles were transformed when the Holy Spirit came upon them. In the same way, when the Holy Spirit fills our lives, our experience is marked by a profound sense of God's love and power, an eagerness to share this news with those around us and a renewed desire to praise God.

I invite all of you today to say that ancient prayer, "Veni Sancte Spiritu", "Come Holy Spirit."

Baptisms at Most Holy Redeemer: If you would like your child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer then you must first arrange an appointment to see Father Dan. Rather than emailing or phoning the parish office the best way to do this is to speak to Father Dan after the Parish Mass that you normally attend at the weekend. In order for a child to be baptised at Most Holy Redeemer at least one of the parents must be a baptised Catholic and we do expect parents to be attending Mass regularly with their children.
